MINISTRY OF INTERIOR

Decision 1228/2022 (IV. 14.) of the Government
on the 2022-2023 Action Plan for the implementation of the 2020-2023 National
Anti-Trafficking Strategy

1. The Government, as set out in Appendix 1, adopts the Action Plan for the implementation of the National Anti-Trafficking Strategy for 2020-2023 (hereinafter referred to as the Action Plan), as set out in Government Decision 1046/2020 (II. 18.) on the National Anti-Trafficking Strategy for 2020-2023 and the Action Plan to be implemented in the period 2020-2021, and agrees with the measurable objectives for the implementation of the measures, the definition of the scope and means of the necessary interventions, and the personnel, material, professional, financial and organizational conditions for the implementation of the measures.

2. The Government calls on the Minister of Interior to implement the Action Plan with the involvement of the relevant and competent ministers.

<i>Responsible body:</i>	Minister of Interior with the involvement of ministers with relevant responsibilities
<i>Deadline:</i>	31 December 2023

3. The Government calls on the Minister of Finance, with the involvement of the Minister of Human Capacities and the Minister of the Prime Minister's Office, to provide the necessary resources to implement the Action Plan, as follows:

- a) in the amount of HUF 341 million in 2023, in the chapter of the Ministry of Human Capacities of the 2023 central budget,
- b) from the year 2023 onwards, in the amount of HUF 12 million per year, as a built-in amount, under the Prime Minister's Office chapter of the central budget of the given year.

4. The Government agrees that the resource requirements of the Action Plan for the year 2023 should be financed, as far as possible, from the Swiss–Hungarian Cooperation Program Period II available to Hungary, following its adoption.

5. The Government calls on the Minister of the Prime Minister's Office to take into account the costs of the Action Plan with the indicative resource requirements when

planning and designing the frameworks of the Swiss–Hungarian Cooperation Program Period II available to Hungary.

6. The Government invites the Prosecutor General and the President of the National Office for the Judiciary to contribute to the implementation of the Action Plan in their respective fields of expertise.

7. This Decision shall enter into force on the day following its publication and shall expire on 1 January 2024.

8. Points 4 and 5 of Government Decision No 1046/2020 (II. 18.) on the National Anti-Trafficking Strategy for 2020–2023 and the Action Plan to be implemented in the period 2020–2021 shall cease to apply.
